SFSP for Summer 2022

- There are NO waivers for SFSP Summer 2022
- Sites must meet the 50% F & R eligibility requirement or be approved by census
- Meals must be consumed on site, only one meal may be given at a time and no parent pick-up of meals is allowed

SY 21-22 & SSO

- The current waivers that are allowing **SSO** flexibilities do extend until June 30, 2022, but that is only for SSO not SFSP IF you meet the area eligibility requirements
- Participating SSO sites within the district must be 50% F & R or be located in an attendance area that qualifies otherwise SSO must end on the last day school. Census can be used.
- Only two meals may be served and claimed through SSO. Any combination except Lunch and Supper together.

CACFP At-Risk

- CACFP At-Risk **MUST** stop on your last day of school, it cannot go into June.

School Year 2022-2023

- We currently have no guidance from USDA for SY 22-23
- We have been told to prepare for normal NSLP and SBP

State Match Payments

- State Match was paid on April 23
- The second half of State Match will be paid in May 2022

Meal Patterns for SY 22-23 - Milk

- 1% flavored milk may be served in SY 22-23. Flavored fat free is still allowed.
- Requires unflavored milk, 1% or fat free, to be offered at each NSLP/SBP service
- 1% flavored is allowed for Smart Snacks, Special Milk for ages 6 and up and CACFP for ages 6 and up
- Required to serve unflavored in addition to flavored

Meal Patterns for SY 22-23 - Sodium

- Maintain Target 1 for NSLP & SBP in SY 2022-23, effective July 1, 2022
- Implement Interim Target 1A for NSLP in SY 2023-24, effective July 1, 2023
- Maintain Target 1 for SBP in SY 2023-24, effective July 1, 2023

Meal Patterns for SY 22-23 – Whole Grain

- At least 80% of grains offered must be whole grain-rich
- The remaining grains must be enriched
- Provides flexibility for program operators to offer enriched grains when whole grain-rich items are unavailable or when the whole grain-rich item is not acceptable by students

3-Month Operating Balance

- A few adjustments are being made based on a discussion with OCAS regarding an amount that was included for some districts that should not have been

Memo-SP 03-2022 Supply Chain Assistance (SCA) Funds

The first round of SCA funds were paid on March 24 into your State Aid account, these are CN funds and need to be treated and coded as such.

There will be a reallocation amount paid due to about 20-25 schools opting out of these funds.

Once we have all the attestation statements returned we will know the reallocated amount and pay the rest of the funds to the districts that opted in

Equipment Purchase Approvals-Reminder

- SFA's must have State Agency Approval for equipment acquisition of \$5,000.00 or more per item.
 - Pre-Approval list of equipment can be found on page P-8 of the CNP Manual (if on list, considered pre-approved)
 - **Not on list, must have Jennifer Weber's approval before PURCHASING**
 - If item is to be used exclusively by Child Nutrition all cost are allowable and can be paid with CN funds
 - If item is to be shared with another entity in the school district the cost must be prorated using the Indirect Cost Rate or other means
 - Proper procurement must be followed, two or more quotes must be obtained

CEP in SY 22-23

- If you are considering CEP for SY 22-23, you need to pull your Direct Cert info from the WAVE now and print an enrollment list for this timeframe (April)
- You must let the State agency know on or before June 30, 2022 if you are choosing to elect CEP for SY 22-23

Provision 2 or 3 for SY 22-23

- If you are considering Provision 2 or 3 for SY 22-23 you will need to apply on or before August 1, 2022
- SY 22-23 would be your base year and Free/Reduced applications must be collected
- The higher Free/Reduced your district is the better. We recommend 90% more

Paid Lunch Equity (PLE)

- USDA did waive the PLE Tool reporting requirement for SY 21-22
- You are still required to charge students for paid meals at a price that is, on average, equal to the difference between the free meal reimbursement and the paid meal reimbursement rate
