Page C-29	Added: #3. If the district has any sites that are nonpricing or Provision, the district MUST pay back the nonprofit school food service account when the overall nonprofit school food service account activity is insufficient to cover Program costs. The District must pay the difference from a non-Federal source. (USDA Provision 2 Guidance pg. 50) Added: #4. If Child Nutrition is to be paid back funds, the district will use Program Code 700 and Project Reporting code 000 (Do not use Project code 763, 764, 769, etc). This will only be used if the district uses both Fund 11 and Fund 22.
Page C-30	Added codes 761 and 792 in the Three-month operating balance formula. (These codes are used for emergency funding)

Page C-45	Added: Note: If the district has any sites that are nonpricing or Provision, the district MUST pay back the nonprofit school food service account when the overall nonprofit school food service account activity is insufficient to cover Program costs. The District must pay the difference from a non-Federal source. (USDA Provision 2 Guidance pg. 50)

- Page CM-10 Grains changed from whole grains being served 50% for the week to all grains served must be whole grain-rich.
- Page CM-11 Flavored was removed from Lowfat (1%) milk. The requirement is unflavored lowfat (1%) only.
- Page CM-24 Added: D. Annual training on Offer vs Serve is required to meet the professional standard requirement.
- Page CM-90 Added: All districts must have a designated Child Nutrition Director and it is required they receive 12 hours of professional development each year.
